

TSHIRELETSO PRIMARY SCHOOL IN ALLENRIDGE TO RECEIVE MULTIPURPOSE SPORT COURT

Sporting codes to be played include 5 a-side Soccer, Netball, Volleyball, Tennis and Basketball This state of the Art facility has twenty (20) years life span and fifteen (15) years warranty and was audited as a "zero waste" as well as an environmentally friendly facility. They also allow for training and development courses for local coaches to improve upon their skills and excel in their respective sport codes.
