ACT

Subject to the provisions of the Exchequer Act, 1994 (Act No 1 of 1994), there are hereby appropriated out of the Provincial Revenue Fund for the requirements of the Province, in respect of the financial year ending 31 March 1998, as a charge of the Provincial Revenue Account, the adjusted amounts of money shown in column 1 of the Schedule.
