ACT

To appropriate an amount of money for the requirements of the Province in respect of the financial year ending 31 March 1997.

BE IT ENACTED by the Provincial Legislature of the Free State Province, as follows :-

Appropriation of moneys for requirements of the province

1. Subject to the provisions of the Exchequer Act, 1994 (Act No 1 of 1994), there are hereby appropriated out of the Provincial Revenue Fund for the requirements of the Province in respect of the financial year ending 31 March 1997, as a charge to the Provincial Revenue Account, the amounts of money shown in column 1 of the Schedule.

Short title

2. This Act shall be called the Appropriation Act, 1996.
